R E A D

Luke 7:36-50

- 1) What is the significance of Simon inviting Jesus to his home for a meal? What do you think motivated Simon's invitation?
- 2) What is the significance of the woman crying at Jesus' feet? What do you think motivated the woman's response to Jesus?
- 3) What point do you think Jesus is making through his parable in verses 41-43? What is being exposed or revealed through the story of two debtors?

Read slowly and prayerfully through the story again.

- 4) What word or phrase do you sense the Spirit asking you to pay attention to?

R E S P O N D

Invite the Holy Spirit to show you the next step of responsiveness that leads toward fullness of life.

Share with others the step that you feel you're being invited to take.

*Share how the Spirit is inviting you to respond today and the week to come – to **be with** Jesus, to **become like** Jesus, or to **do what** Jesus does.*

P R A Y

Pray courage for one another as God continues to use this story in bringing us closer to him and one another.

Take time to wait and pray together. What is Jesus praying for? Come into agreement with His prayers.
